Allegra Hope, LCSWA, is a trauma therapist at Dove House Children's Advocacy Center, where she has dedicated the past 10 years to serving children and families impacted by abuse and maltreatment. She holds a Master's degree in Social Work from UNC Charlotte and is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker Associate with specialized experience supporting children and adolescents in their healing journey following abuse.

Allegra is deeply passionate about protecting and advocating for children who have experienced trauma. Allegra began her journey to advocacy working at Dove House as the Community Outreach Coordinator, teaching abuse prevention curriculum to elementary students. She then transitioned to the Family Advocate role where she got to walk alongside families as they went through the CAC process and court adjudication. In 2024 Allegra decided it was time to venture into her dream role as the first on-staff therapist at Dove House, where she provides trauma-informed therapy and plays a vital role in helping children feel safe, heard, and empowered as they recover from abuse.

As a keynote speaker, Allegra shares the story of a real Dove House client, highlighting the critical role of Children's Advocacy Centers in supporting vulnerable children, strengthening families, and fostering healthier communities. Her work reflects a steadfast dedication to ensuring that every child has access to safety, healing, and hope.
